OT Unit: Women of Faith, Lesson 1

**D6 Family Theme:**  
A CHOICE OF FAITH

**Objectives:**

**Know:** Ruth chose to leave her people and false gods to embrace her mother-in-law Naomi, the Israelites, and God Almighty.

**Think:** Have the mindset that others' needs are as important as my own.

**Do:** Commit to God and serve those around us in need.



## READ: LISTEN TO GOD

**Read Ruth 1:1-22.** Difficult circumstances and grief come to every family. A young Moabite woman made a choice in faith to leave behind her ungodly culture and embrace God and her widowed mother-in-law.



## PRAY: TALK TO GOD

We stay committed to loved ones even when they are struggling. Pray that you and your family would be aware of those around you that are hurting. Pray that you would stick with them like Ruth stuck with Naomi.



## DO: WALK WITH GOD

**Option 1:** Naomi gave Orpah and Ruth the chance to return home to their families after the death of their husbands. Ruth took a step of faith in choosing to leave behind what she knew in order to follow her mother-in-law, which meant accepting her God. Ruth was considering Naomi's needs before her own. Prepare a special treat for your child, like cookies or some candy. Put them in a corner of the biggest room in your house, and turn off all the lights. Lead your child to the treat with a flashlight. Explain that he or she made a choice of faith that you would lead him or her safely to the end, just like Ruth trusted Naomi's God.

**Option 2:** Ask your family why it is dangerous when a lifeguard tries to help someone who is panicking and drowning. (They have to approach carefully, often from behind, or the panicked swimmer may end up taking them both under!). Ask your family to list other situations in which someone who desperately needs help makes it hard to help.
