NT Unit: Living In Christ, Lesson 3

D6 Family Theme:
CONTENT IN CHRIST

Objectives:

Know: God desires us to find contentment in Him no matter our circumstances.

Think: View my circumstances as opportunities to serve and worship God.

Do: Cultivate a spirit of contentment in all circumstances.



READ: LISTEN TO GOD

Read 1 Corinthians 7:1-40. Although contentment seems to be a forgotten idea in today's culture, it is still a biblical mandate. As Christ-followers, we must practice and demonstrate the art of contentment.



PRAY: TALK TO GOD

Give the Lord priority in your life, whatever your circumstances. Pray that you and your family would find contentment in your relationships, jobs, and ministries.



DO: WALK WITH GOD

Option 1: Throughout your life you will go through many different circumstances, but all are part of God's plan. God calls us to be content no matter what we are going through. Even in hard times, find ways that you can worship God. Have your children choose three toys to play with for the whole week. Explain to them that it is important for them to be happy with what they have. Remind them that there are children that only have a few toys, so we need to be thankful for all of the blessings God has given us. The more we are aware of the blessings He has given us, the more we will praise Him when things get tough.

Option 2: Read Philippians 4:11 with your family. After reading it, ask the following questions:

- *When do you most tend to struggle with contentment?*
- *Is it possible to be genuinely content and still be working to better your situation? Why or why not?*
- *Why is it important to be content in every situation?*
